

Using the Phones Plus Search Page

Tips

You must enter information in at least one field. Searching by multiple fields increases your search precision, and therefore results in fewer documents that meet your exact criteria. To search more broadly, use fewer fields. When searching on common names, please complete as many fields as you can to avoid unduly large result sets.

Last Name

Enter your subject's last name in the Last Name field.

*Example: **Doe or Dough***

First Name

Enter your subject's first name in the First Name field.

*Example: **John or Jack***

Middle Initial

Enter the subject's middle initial in the Middle Initial field. Some records do not contain middle initials and will be excluded.

*Example: **J***

Street

Enter the street address in the Street Address field.

*Example: **123 Main Street***

City

You can limit your search to specific cities.

*Example: **New York***

State

If you need assistance with the state abbreviation, you can click on the word "state" above the state field and then click on the appropriate state, which will auto-fill the state field.

Zip

You can enter a zip code to limit your search to a specific geographical area. We recommend you limit your entry to the 5-digit form most commonly used.

*Example: **12345***

Telephone

Enter all or part of the telephone number.

*Example: **(858) 554-8620***

Include DA Listings

You can elect to include phone listings from Directory Assistance in your search by checking the "Include DA Listings" checkbox.

Reference Code

A free form input field provided to identify your research.

*Example: **Apollo Project***

*Example: **A1234/B-55***
